Gentlemen:

We have audited the recorded cash receipts and disbursements of the **California Labor League For Political Education** for the period March 1, 1949 to November 30, 1950. In connection therewith, we examined or tested accounting records and other supporting evidence.

Cash receipts, as recorded and evidenced by duplicate receipts on file, were found to have been regularly deposited in the bank. Disbursements were evidenced by paid canceled checks on file which we compared with the cash book entries as to payees and amounts, and scrutinized as to signatures and endorsements. Disbursements were either supported by vouchers or approved for payment by Mr. C. J. Haggerty, Secretary-Treasurer.

The commercial account maintained with Bank of America N.T.&S.A., Humboldt Branch, San Francisco, was reconciled with the bank statements on file for the period ended November 30, 1950. The balance on deposit as of November 30, 1950, as shown on exhibit A, attached, was confirmed by correspondence with the depository.
